## College of Languages, Linguistics & Literature 2017 Junior/Mid-Career Faculty Excellence in Scholarship & Research Award

The purpose of this award is to recognize junior/mid-career faculty members in the College of Languages, Linguistics & Literature (LLL) who demonstrate strong potential for significant scholarship and research accomplishments. Award amount is \$1,000\* to be used for scholarly and research activities.

#### Terms of award

Recipient will be recognized at the annual LLL Aloha Reception. If the award recipient has a 2-2 or more teaching load in the next academic year (2017-18), recipient will receive a single course release for that year. The recipient will also be asked to serve as a plenary speaker for the 2017 LLL Graduate Conference scheduled for April 22, 2017 (Saturday).

#### **Eligibility**

Full-time tenure-track faculty members with at least a 50% FTE in LLL during each of the last two years (or since spring 2015) and who are one of the following:

- Assistant Professor (I3)
- Junior Specialist (S3)
- Associate Professor (I4) promoted to the current rank on or after August 1, 2013 AND also not applying for promotion to Professor (I5) during the current academic year
- Associate Specialist (S4) promoted to the current rank on or after August 1, 2013 AND also not applying for promotion to Specialist (S5) during the current academic year

Faculty on 100% LWOP during fall 2016 and/or spring 2017 are ineligible.

Prior recipients of the Junior/Mid-Career Faculty Excellence in Scholarship & Research Award are ineligible.

#### **Application Procedure**

Prepare an application packet (submit in order listed and no more than what is listed):

- 1. A completed application packet cover form (form fillable version; see next page)
- 2. A blurb about yourself as an accomplished scholar/researcher in the field (do not exceed 500 words)
- 3. A complete curriculum vitae

Extended Deadline: Friday, February 17, 2017 (incomplete or late applications will not be considered

### **Selection Criteria**

A committee appointed by the Dean will review all applications and select a recipient based on:

- 1. Quantity and quality of scholarly/research as an LLL faculty member
- 2. Relevance of scholarly work to the faculty member's field of study and professional expertise
