German Professor Receives Appointments by Fulbright Commission



Christina Gerhardt has been appointed [Fulbright Program](#) Director and Fulbright Program Advisor for UH Mānoa. The Fulbright Commission provides grants for UH faculty, graduate students, and undergraduate students to carry out individually designed research projects or to serve abroad as English Teaching Assistants. Grant recipients conduct their work in a participating country outside the United States. They meet, work, live with, and learn from people of the host country as U.S. cultural ambassadors. In addition, applicants from other countries can apply to be in residence at UH Mānoa.

As Fulbright Program Director, Professor Gerhardt's primary responsibilities are to promote the Fulbright Commission's offerings; to provide information and guidance to interested applicants; and to organize interviews and review applications.

Christina Gerhardt, Associate Professor of German in the Department of Languages and Literatures of Europe and the Americas, is eminently qualified for the position. She received a year-long award from the Fulbright Commission to conduct archival research at the Hamburg Institute for Social Research. She has also served previously on the Fulbright selection committee at UH Mānoa. "I am honored by this appointment," said Gerhardt. "I look forward to opening a world of opportunities to colleagues, graduate students and undergraduate students through the Fulbright Commission."

The College of Languages, Linguistics & Literature (one of the four Arts & Sciences colleges) of the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa offers a broad curriculum in English, foreign and heritage languages and literatures, second language studies, and linguistics.
