Titaua Porcher-Wiart is associate professor at the Université de la Polynésie Française where she teaches 20th-21st literature and French speaking Pacific literature. She published in 2011 a book about the French author Pierre Jean Jouve (*Pierre Jean Jouve: Mystère et sens dans l'oeuvre Romanesque*) and she has been working on Oceanian literatures for ten years now. She worked at UH in 2011 and kept very strong links with this university. In 2017, she co-edited a special issue on francophone literature in 2017 in *Interculturel Francophonies* and a special issue of the New Zealand Journal of French Studies on “literature and politics”. In October 2018, she published a play titled *Hina, Maui and Company*.
